They also have two grandchildren, Dustin & Briana.

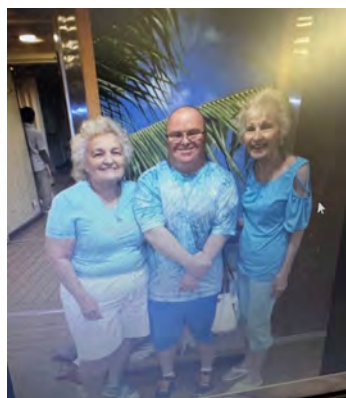
Bette was Vice President of Sheraton Corporation. She and her husband also owned three businesses. The couple were motivational speakers. They would travel in Europe and the

HALLOWEEN FUN FACTS



- 1. Because the movie Halloween (1978) was on such a tight budget, they had to use the cheapest mask they could find for the character Michael Meyers, which turned out to be a William Shatner Star Trek mask. Shatner initially didn’t know the mask was in his likeness, but when he found out years later, he said he was honored.
- 2. The first Jack O’Lanterns were actually made from turnips.
- 3. Samhainophobia is the fear of Halloween.
- 4. The owl is a popular Halloween image. In Medieval Europe, owls were though to be witches, and to hear an owl's call meant someone was about to die
- 5. According to Irish legend, Jack O’Lanterns are named after a stingy man named Jack who, because he tricked the devil several times, was forbidden entrance into both heaven and hell. He was condemned to wander the Earth, waving his lantern to lead people away from their paths.
- 6. Stephen Clarke holds the record for the world’s fastest pumpkin carving time: 24.03 seconds, smashing his previous record of 54.72 seconds. The rules of the competition state that the pumpkin must weigh less than 24 pounds and be carved in a traditional way, which requires at least eyes, nose, ears, and a mouth.
- 7. The first known mention of trick-or-treating in print in North America occurred in 1927 in Blackie, Alberta, Canada.
- 8. Black and orange are typically associated with Halloween. Orange is a symbol of strength and endurance and, along with brown and gold, stands for the harvest and autumn. Black is typically a symbol of death and darkness and acts as a reminder that Halloween once was a festival that marked the boundaries between life and death
- 9. Ireland is typically believed to be the birthplace of Halloween
- 10. Scarecrows, a popular Halloween fixture, symbolize the ancient agricultural roots of the holiday
- 11. Celebrities born on Halloween include Rob Schneider, Vanilla Ice, Dermot Mulroney, Peter Jackson, and Ron Rifkin
- 12. Harry Houdini (1874-1926) was one of the most famous and mysterious magicians who ever lived. Strangely enough, he died in 1926 on Halloween night as a result of appendicitis brought on by three stomach punches
- 13. Scottish girls believed they could see images of their future husband if they hung wet sheets in front of the fire on Halloween. Other girls believed they would see their boyfriend’s faces if they looked into mirrors while walking downstairs at midnight on Halloween
- 14. According to tradition, if a person wears his or her clothes inside out and then walks backwards on Halloween, he or she will see a witch at midnight. Wearing clothes inside out symbolized the world turning upside down, and walking backwards at midnight was thought to allow someone to see things that are normally hidden, such as witches
- 15. Mexico celebrates the Days of the Dead (Días de los Muertos) on the Christian holidays All Saints’ Day (November 1) and All Souls’ Day (November 2) instead of Halloween. The townspeople dress up like ghouls and parade down the street
- 16. A statue of Jason Voorhees, the movie serial killer from Friday the 13th, was placed at the bottom of a Minnesota Lake in 2013 and is still there
- 17. First created in the 1880s, Candy Corn was originally called "Chicken Feed.
- 18. Finding a spider on Halloween is considered good luck and was often interpreted as a sign that a deceased relative was watching you
- 19. In 1974, eight-year-old Timothy O’Bryan died of cyanide poisoning after eating Halloween candy. Investigators later learned that his father had taken out a \$20,000 life insurance policy on each of his children and that he had poisoned his own son and also attempted to poison his daughter
- 20. The longest haunted house in the world is "Factory of Terror" in Canton, Ohio
- 21.Teng Chieh or the Lantern Festival is one Halloween festival in China. Lanterns shaped like dragons and other animals are hung around houses and streets to help guide the spirits back to their earthly homes. To honor their deceased loved ones, family members leave food and water by the portraits of their ancestors
- 22. The sounds of stabbing in the Halloween movie is made by a knife being plunged into a watermelon
- 23. Michael Jackson's 1982 "Thriller" was originally called "Starlight."
- 24. A child born on Halloween is said to have the ability to talk to spirits
- 25. The blockbuster movie Halloween was filmed in just 21 days.
- 26. The original creator of Milk Duds wanted to make the candies into perfect circles. When that proved impossible, he called them "duds." He added the word "milk" to refer to the large amount of milk used to make the candy
- 27. Both Salem, Massachusetts, and Anoka, Minnesota, are the self-proclaimed Halloween capitals of the world
- 28. The movie Halloween was originally titled Babysitter Murders
- 29. Illinois produces five times more pumpkins than any other state
- 30. The least healthy Halloween candy is Candy Corn. Just 15 pieces of Candy Corn equal 110 calories and 22 grams of sugar. The healthiest Halloween candy is Hershey’s Special Dark

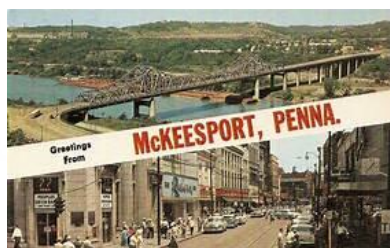
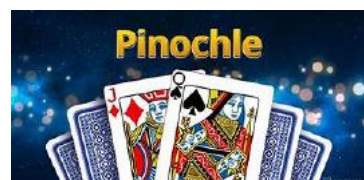
The couple had four children together, Andrew, Paul, Linda & Nancy. Gloria also has six grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

HALLOWEEN FUN FACTS



- 1. Because the movie Halloween (1978) was on such a tight budget, they had to use the cheapest mask they could find for the character Michael Meyers, which turned out to be a William Shatner Star Trek mask. Shatner initially didn't know the mask was in his likeness, but when he found out years later, he said he was honored.
- 2. The first Jack O'Lanterns were actually made from turnips.
- 3. Samhainophobia is the fear of Halloween.
- 4. The owl is a popular Halloween image. In Medieval Europe, owls were thought to be witches, and to hear an owl's call meant someone was about to die
- 5. According to Irish legend, Jack O'Lanterns are named after a stingy man named Jack who, because he tricked the devil several times, was forbidden entrance into both heaven and hell. He was condemned to wander the Earth, waving his lantern to lead people away from their paths.
- 6. Stephen Clarke holds the record for the world's fastest pumpkin carving time: 24.03 seconds, smashing his previous record of 54.72 seconds. The rules of the competition state that the pumpkin must weigh less than 24 pounds and be carved in a traditional way, which requires at least eyes, nose, ears, and a mouth.
- 7. The first known mention of trick-or-treating in print in North America occurred in 1927 in Blackie, Alberta, Canada.
- 8. Black and orange are typically associated with Halloween. Orange is a symbol of strength and endurance and, along with brown and gold, stands for the harvest and autumn. Black is typically a symbol of death and darkness and acts as a reminder that Halloween once was a festival that marked the boundaries between life and death
- 9. Ireland is typically believed to be the birthplace of Halloween
- 10. Scarecrows, a popular Halloween fixture, symbolize the ancient agricultural roots of the holiday
- 11. Celebrities born on Halloween include Rob Schneider, Vanilla Ice, Dermot Mulroney, Peter Jackson, and Ron Rifkin
- 12. Harry Houdini (1874-1926) was one of the most famous and mysterious magicians who ever lived. Strangely enough, he died in 1926 on Halloween night as a result of appendicitis brought on by three stomach punches
- 13. Scottish girls believed they could see images of their future husband if they hung wet sheets in front of the fire on Halloween. Other girls believed they would see their boyfriend's faces if they looked into mirrors while walking downstairs at midnight on Halloween
- 14. According to tradition, if a person wears his or her clothes inside out and then walks backwards on Halloween, he or she will see a witch at midnight. Wearing clothes inside out symbolized the world turning upside down, and walking backwards at midnight was thought to allow someone to see things that are normally hidden, such as witches
- 15. Mexico celebrates the Days of the Dead (Días de los Muertos) on the Christian holidays All Saints' Day (November 1) and All Souls' Day (November 2) instead of Halloween. The townspeople dress up like ghouls and parade down the street
- 16. A statue of Jason Voorhees, the movie serial killer from Friday the 13th, was placed at the bottom of a Minnesota Lake in 2013 and is still there
- 17. First created in the 1880s, Candy Corn was originally called "Chicken Feed."
- 18. Finding a spider on Halloween is considered good luck and was often interpreted as a sign that a deceased relative was watching you
- 19. In 1974, eight-year-old Timothy O'Bryan died of cyanide poisoning after eating Halloween candy. Investigators later learned that his father had taken out a \$20,000 life insurance policy on each of his children and that he had poisoned his own son and also attempted to poison his daughter
- 20. The longest haunted house in the world is "Factory of Terror" in Canton, Ohio
- 21.Teng Chieh or the Lantern Festival is one Halloween festival in China. Lanterns shaped like dragons and other animals are hung around houses and streets to help guide the spirits back to their earthly homes. To honor their deceased loved ones, family members leave food and water by the portraits of their ancestors
- 22. The sounds of stabbing in the Halloween movie is made by a knife being plunged into a watermelon
- 23. Michael Jackson's 1982 "Thriller" was originally called "Starlight."
- 24. A child born on Halloween is said to have the ability to talk to spirits
- 25. The blockbuster movie Halloween was filmed in just 21 days.
- 26. The original creator of Milk Duds wanted to make the candies into perfect circles. When that proved impossible, he called them "duds." He added the word "milk" to refer to the large amount of milk used to make the candy
- 27. Both Salem, Massachusetts, and Anoka, Minnesota, are the self-proclaimed Halloween capitals of the world
- 28. The movie Halloween was originally titled Babysitter Murders
- 29. Illinois produces five times more pumpkins than any other state
- 30. The least healthy Halloween candy is Candy Corn. Just 15 pieces of Candy Corn equal 110 calories and 22 grams of sugar. The healthiest Halloween candy is Hershey's Special Dark
