In the U.S., people spend billions of dollars on Mother's Day each year on gifts, flowers, cards, and meals!

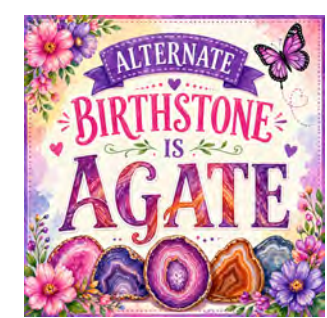
Carnations are the traditional flower of Mother's Day. Pink carnations represent gratitude, while white symbolize pure love.
